Happy Birthday, Hape Kerkeling! On 9 December, the entertainer and author will be celebrating his 50th birthday. The ZDF TV channel is honouring him on Sunday, 30 November at 10pm with the "Keine Geburtstagsshow!" (Not a Birthday Show!). The show will feature Hape Kerkeling, Horst Schlämmer, der lustige Glückshase, Hannilein, Barbara Schöneberger and dancers of the Friedrichstadt-Palast ballet company. The Palast was selected by ZDF as the perfect venue for the birthday show: After all, what better place for Germany's greatest comedian than the largest theatre stage in the world?

The gala documentary depicts the chaotic preparations for a birthday show in the style of "This is Your Life" that will never actually take place. Hape Kerkeling plays three protagonists who, during the gala rehearsals, brilliantly obstruct the proceedings, preventing it from becoming the kind of regular birthday show that so many other stars long for. Barbara Schöneberger plays the increasingly irritated presenter of the birthday show, until she finally throws in the towel.

Gero von Boehm, screenwriter Micky Beisenherz and Hape Kerkeling created and realized the major project together. "It was a dream come true for me as a director to have an opportunity to work on the largest theatre stage in the world", said Gero von

Boehm, who was also the show's producer. "To stage the organized chaos of a big show, we needed the perfect location. Shooting crazy scenes and at the same time making fun of some leading media personalities is the icing on the cake for a screenwriter. I'm looking forward to the show which doesn't happen", added writer Micky Beisenherz.

The show will be given its TV broadcast on ZDF next Sunday, 30 November 2014, at 10pm. A sneak preview will be shown on Saturday, 29 November 2014, at 8:15 pm on ZDFneo.
