**When gladiator rain into the snow-heroes: Hollywood heavyweight Ralf Moeller recently visited the Friedrichstadt-Palast's multi award-winning young ensemble. With 1.96 metres of pure power, he brought a final spurt of motivation to the rehearsals of our latest production, Keinschneechaos.**

Ralf Moeller gave the kids some last minute tips for their search for the snow, met the pink cuddly rabbit, and rehearsed with Emil, Ferdinand & Co. as they performed the world's most elaborate children's show. The glamour of Hollywood in Berlin's East End!

For the last 22 years, the actor has lived and worked in Los Angeles. Ralf Moeller is committed to helping socially disadvantaged young people in Germany. His main concerns are immigration and integration. With the "Prevent violence – promote integration" project, the 54 year-old speaks to young people across Germany about his own experiences as a child from humble beginnings. He encourages young people to actively speak out against violence and for more tolerance.

"With self-confidence, courage and a strong will, you can achieve a lot – also away from the stage. At the Friedrichstadt-Palast, children from the most varied of backgrounds are rehearsing together peacefully for their great children's show, and are calling for a rebellion against climate change in 'Keinschneechaos'. It makes sense for me to help them get into shape for their adventure", says Ralf Moeller.
