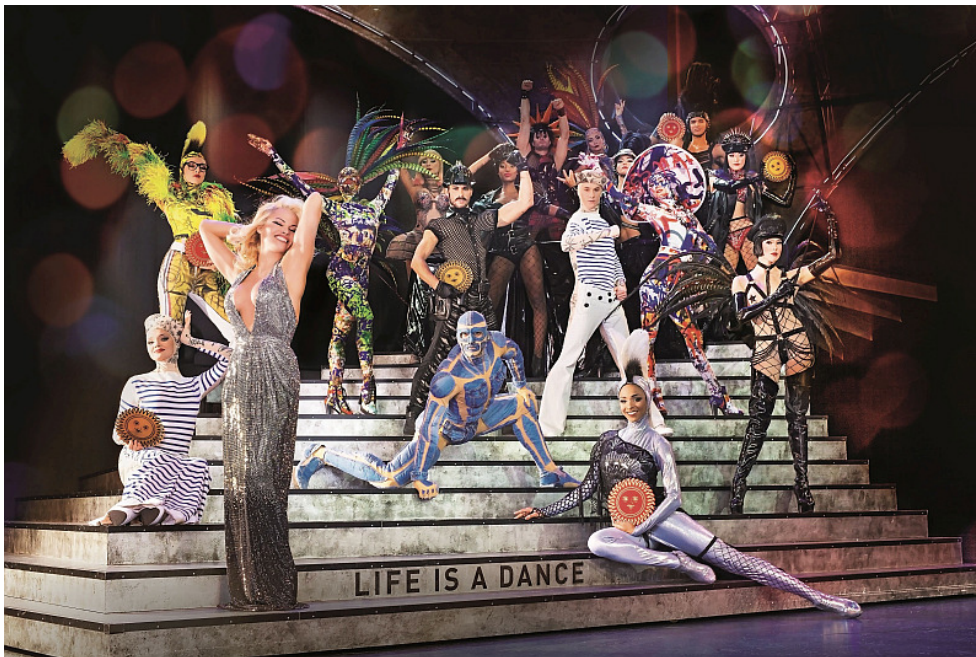

For the calendar photo with Pamela Anderson, the Palast's dancers wore costumes from the current THE ONE Grand Show. The Grand Show is set in a long-abandoned revue theatre, where an underground party revives the glitz and glamour of bygone times. The flamboyant costumes were designed by international star of haute couture, Jean-Paul GAULTIER.

THE ONE Grand Show is the most successful production in the Palast's 98-year history. Since the premiere in October 2016, more than 600,000 tickets have been sold. Audience reviews for the revue show, which runs until July 2018, have been overwhelmingly positive at 94 percent on TripAdvisor and 96 percent on Facebook.
