FALLING | IN LOVE Grand Show bids farewell with historic attendance record of more than 900,000 guests!

Berlin, 7 July 2025

On Saturday night, FALLING | IN LOVE bid farewell to the world's biggest theatre stage with a celebratory derniere and one final curtain call. Jean Paul GAULTIER, who curated the Grand Show, attended in person. It was already clear two months before this final performance that FALLING | IN LOVE would be the most successful Grand Show in the Friedrichstadt-Palast's over 100-year history. After Saturday night's derniere, the final figures are now in: FALLING | IN LOVE just managed to break the historic total of 900,000 guests. The Palast has never seen anything like it in its more than 100 years!

To sum up: there were a total of 908,000 guests and €61.1 million was generated in ticket sales – this is also a new record! With 1,899 seats filled every night and 511 performances, the Grand Show curated by Jean Paul GAULTIER achieved an overall occupancy rate of 93.66%. As such, FALLING | IN LOVE outdid by €13.9 million the previous hit show ARISE (2021–2023), which set new standards with €47.2 million in ticket sales. THE ONE (2016–2018) previously held the attendance record with 804,000 guests (ticket sales of €44.1 million). FALLING | IN LOVE surpassed this by 100,000 guests!
